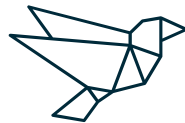

1 Multi-channel capability

With the new release, Universal provides a web-interface (API) which allows to connect third party applications. Any kind of internet- or extranet-application can be integrated via standard web-technology to Universal. You might think of integrating Universal into your customer portal or making Universal accessible for brokers within your extranet.

2 Security

With regard to the multi-channel capability various threat scenarios have been analysed and counter measures have been implemented to prevent typical attacks. Furthermore, the password encryption of Universal's proprietary authentication has been improved.

3 Performance

Performance is under continuous improvement. With the new release, the screen builds up faster for complex embedded and nested elements, giving the user the ability to execute business transactions in a far more efficient way. This results in a better user experience and a greater acceptance for Universal.

4 Usability

Due to the responsive design the screen will be automatically adjusted to the display and boosts the ergonomics on multiple devices like laptops or ipads.

Adjusted column widths of tables are stored in a user specific configuration applied on every login of the user. Therefore, the user does not have to establish his manual settings for the column widths any time he starts up Universal.





5 Miscellaneous Features

- Copy & paste from word files into Universal is a way more comfortable now. Text attributes like bullet-points or text colour can be copied 1:1 from Word to Universal. Equally simple is the import of tables.
- The chapter number of any component can be used for further processing. This can be used for example as reference in e-mails, warnings or messages.
- Additional table columns can be imported to support country specific information for one standard field.
- The synchronization with back-end systems can run automatically.
- The datamart is capable to analyse whole text passages. This new feature can for example be used to identify new or changed legal clauses.
